



1. **SOMETIMES GOD ALLOWS US TO BE IN A PRECARIOUS SITUATION IN WHICH THE ONLY DIRECTION WE CAN TURN IS HIM.** (Daniel 2:1-11)

2. **WHEN TOUGH TIMES COME, HOW WE RESPOND TELLS A LOT ABOUT US.** (Daniel 2:12-28)

A. First, take a **GOD-VIEW** of the situation.

1. When a threat comes against you, first, seek out the best **INFORMATION** you can find to help you accurately understand what, why and how.

2. Find **SUPPORTIVE** relationships who can stand with you in the crisis. (Daniel 2:17)

Proverbs 27:17 *“Iron sharpens iron; so a man sharpens the countenance of his friend.”*

Deuteronomy 32:30 *“One man can put 1,000 to flight but two men, 10,000.”*

3. With your supportive relationships, go to God in **PRAYER**.

4. Don't stop praying until you have received either a provision or a **PROMISE** from God.

James 5:16 *“...The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.”*

B. When God gives you a promise or a provision, respond to Him in **PRAISE**.

Hebrews 13:15 *“Through Him then, let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name.”*

C. Give credit to God **PUBLICLY** to others.
(Daniel 2:26-28)
