I. INTRODUCTION

- A. *Isaiah 8:22* “Then they will look toward the earth and see only distress and darkness and fearful gloom, and they will be thrust into utter darkness.”
- B. *Isaiah 9:1-2* “Nevertheless, that time of darkness and despair will not go on forever. The land of Zebulun and Naphtali will be humbled, but there will be a time in the future when Galilee of the Gentiles, which lies along the road that runs between the Jordan and the sea, will be filled with glory. <sup>2</sup> The people who walk in darkness will see a great light. For those who live in a land of deep darkness, a light will shine.” (NLT)
- C. *Isaiah 9:6* “For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.”

II. THE HOLY SPIRIT REVEALED TO ISAIAH **WHO** THE MESSIAH WOULD BE. (Isaiah 9:6)

- A. *Hebrews 2:14, 15* “Because God’s children are human beings—made of flesh and blood—the Son also became flesh and blood. For only as a **human being** could he die, and only by dying could he break the power of the devil, who had the power of death. <sup>15</sup> Only in this way could he set free all who have lived their lives as slaves to the fear of dying.” (NLT)
- B. “For God so loved the world, He gave His one and only **Son** that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” (John 3:16)
- C. *Galatians 4:4* “...When the appropriate time had come, God sent forth His **Son** born of a woman.”
