## INTRODUCTION

- I. WE HAVE A SPIRITUAL FAMILY.
  - A. There is a specific time we become a **<u>child</u>** of God and enter God's family.

John 1:12 (NIV) "...<u>To all who received Christ</u>, to those who believed in His name, He gave the <u>right</u> to become children of God."

To be God's child you have to be born <u>again</u>. (John 1:12; John 3:5-7)

B. We are to be a **member** of a local church.

Ephesians 2:19 "... You are a member of God's very own family ... and you <u>belong</u> in God's household with every other Christian."

1. Of the 79 times the word church is used in the Bible, it only refers to it as the universal church 4 times. Every

other time (75 times) in the Bible the word church refers to a <u>local</u> body of believers just like Sugar Creek. The Bible talks a lot about the strong importance of being an active part of a local church.

- 3. The church isn't a building. The church is <u>us</u>.
- 4. When we join a church we are saying:
  - a. These are the people I <u>trust</u> to minister to me.
  - b. These are the people who trust me to minister to them.
  - c. These are people I join to minister to the world together.
- II. WHY IS THIS NEW FAMILY SO IMPORTANT TO OUR DEEPENING RELATIONSHIP TO GOD?
  - A. We were never intended to live this Christian life <u>alone</u>.

Ecclesiastes 4:9-10, 12 "Two are better off than one .... <sup>10</sup> If one of them falls down, the other can help him up. But if someone is alone and falls, it's just too bad, because there is no one to help him.... <sup>12</sup> Two men can resist an attack that would defeat one man alone. A rope made of three cords is hard to break."

B. We need <u>encouragement</u> to grow spiritually.

Hebrews 10:25 "Let us not give up the habit of meeting together, as some are doing. Instead, let us encourage one another...."

C. We make each other better.

Proverbs 27:17 "People learn from one another just as iron <a href="mailto:sharpens">sharpens</a> iron."

- III. THE GREATEST PLACE TO <u>NURTURE</u> AUTHENTIC SPIRITUAL RELATIONSHIPS IS SMALL GROUPS.
  - a. We spend consistent time in small <u>group</u> together inside and outside church activities.

Acts 2:42-47 (NASB) "They were <u>continually devoting</u> <u>themselves</u> to the apostles' teaching and <u>to fellowship</u>, to

the breaking of bread and to prayer. <sup>43</sup> Everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many wonders and signs were taking place through the apostles. <sup>44</sup> And all those who had believed were together and had all things in common; <sup>45</sup> and they began selling their property and possessions and were sharing them with all, as anyone might have need. <sup>46</sup> Day by day continuing with one mind in the temple and breaking bread from house to house, they were taking their meals together with gladness and sincerity of heart, <sup>47</sup> praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord was adding to their number day by day those who were being saved."

B. We unite around God's common <u>purpose</u>. (Acts 2:46)

Acts 2:46 "And day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they were taking their meals together with gladness and sincerity of heart."

C. We help meet each other's **physical** needs. (Acts 2:44-45)

Acts 2:44-45 "All the believers were together and had everything in common. <sup>45</sup> Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need."

D. We <u>carry</u> each other when we are going through hurtful days.

Galatians 6:2 "Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ."
